

1. **Rejuvenate (verb)**

Meaning; To render young again.



Synonyms: recharge, regenerate

Antonyms: discharge, degenerate

2. **Turnout (noun)**

Meaning; The number of people who attend or participate in an event



Synonyms: audience, crowd

Antonyms: single, alone

3. **Agitation (noun)**

Meaning; A stirring up or arousing; disturbance of tranquillity



Synonyms: protest

Antonyms: peace

4. Shamble (verb)

Meaning; To walk while shuffling or dragging the feet.



Synonyms: Stride, tread

Antonyms: unmoving, immobile

5. Steep (verb)

Meaning; To soak or wet thoroughly.



Synonyms: bathe

Antonyms: dry

6. Billow (verb)

Meaning; To swell out or bulge.



Synonyms: bloat

Antonyms: stabilise

7. Decry (verb)

Meaning; To denounce as harmful.



Synonyms: condemn, criticise

Antonyms: praise, applaud
