

1. **Embattle (verb)**

Meaning; To arrange in order of battle; to array for battle



Synonyms: strengthen, fort

Antonyms: weaken, debilitate

2. **Sturdy (adjective)**

Meaning; Of firm build; stiff



Synonyms: well-built

Antonyms: weak

3. **Splurge (verb)**

Meaning; To spend lavishly or extravagantly, especially money



Synonyms: fling, disburse

Antonyms: preserve, hoard

4. Malapert (Adjective)

Meaning; Cheeky, impudent, saucy.



Synonyms: rude

Antonyms: modest

5. Existent (Adjective)

Meaning; existing; having life or being, current; occurring now



Synonyms: extant

Antonyms: nonexistent

6. Thwart (verb)

Meaning; To cause to fail; to frustrate, to prevent.

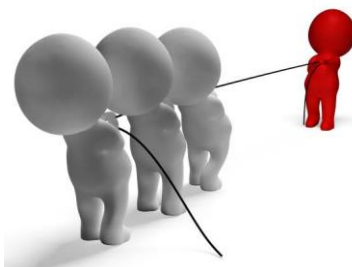


Synonyms: foil, smash
