

1. **Vexatious (Adjective)**

Meaning; Causing vexation or annoyance; teasing; troublesome.



Synonyms: irksome, annoying

Antonyms: pleasing, aiding

2. **Credulous (Adjective)**

Meaning; Excessively ready to believe things



Synonyms: trusting, unworldly

Antonyms: suspicious, worldly

3. **Embellish (verb)**

Meaning; To make more beautiful and attractive



Synonyms: adorn, improve

Antonyms: lessen, reduce

4. Subjugate (verb)

Meaning; To forcibly impose obedience or servitude upon



Synonyms: defeat, conquer

Antonyms: liberate, free

5. Fraught (adjective)

Meaning; Distressed or causing distress



Synonyms: worried, distressed

Antonyms: calm, quiet

6. Reckon (verb)

Meaning; To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



Synonyms: estimate, consider

Antonyms: refuse, avoid

7. Sidle (verb)

Meaning; To (cause something to) move sideways.



Synonyms: slide

Antonyms: stride
