**Meaning;** Of speech or style: brief, concise, to the point.

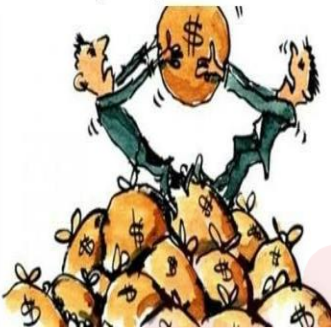


**Synonyms:** laconic, concise

**Antonyms:** elaborate, verbose

### 2. Avaricious (adjective)

**Meaning;** Actuated by avarice; extremely greedy for wealth or material gain



**Synonyms:** greedy, selfish

**Antonyms:** generous, unselfish

### 3. Sordid (adjective)

**Meaning;** Dirty or squalid.



**Synonyms:** miserable, dirty

**Antonyms:** pleasant, clean

**4. Impound (verb)**

**Meaning;** to collect and hold



**Synonyms:** seize

**Antonyms:** release

**5. Conceive (verb)**

**Meaning;** To develop an idea; to form in the mind; to plan; to devise; to originate

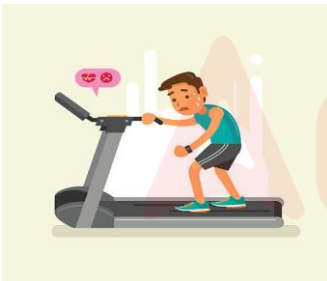


**Synonyms:** assume
