The 78th BAFTA Awards celebrated the finest achievements in cinema, with Conclave and The Brutalist emerging as the biggest winners of the night, each securing four awards. The French musical crime drama Emilia Pérez continued its dominance, winning Best Film Not in the English Language, beating Payal Kapadia's All We Imagine As Light, marking its third major loss to Emilia Pérez this year. Meanwhile, director Brady Corbet (The Brutalist) and lead actor Adrien Brody (The Brutalist) secured top honors. The awards also saw Dune: Part Two winning in technical categories, while Wallace & Gromit: Vengeance Most Fowl took home Best Animated Film.

Awards & Recognition of December 2024

National Panchayat Awards 2024: Celebrating Rural Governance and Sustainable Development

The National Panchayat Awards 2024 marked a significant moment in India's rural development landscape, honoring 45 exceptional Panchayats for their remarkable contributions to sustainable and inclusive growth. Held on December 11, 2024, at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi, the prestigious event was graced by the Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, and the Union Minister of Panchayati Raj, Shri Rajiv Ranjan Singh alias Lalan Singh.

Historical Context and Significance

Constitutional Foundations

The awards commemorate the **73rd Constitutional Amendment Act of 1992**, which granted constitutional status to Panchayats as institutions of local self-governance. Traditionally celebrated on April 24th, the 2024 ceremony was rescheduled due to the **General Elections to the Lok Sabha**.

Scale and Participation

In a testament to grassroots democratic participation, **1.94 lakh Gram Panchayats** competed in this year's awards. Notably, **42% of the 42 award-winning Panchayats** were led by women, highlighting the growing role of female leadership in rural governance.

1. Deen Dayal Upadhyay Panchayat Satat Vikas Puraskar (DDUPSVP)

- Health
- Education
- Water conservation
- Sanitation
- Infrastructure development
- Social justice
- Good governance











2. Nanaji Deshmukh Sarvottam Panchayat Satat Vikas Puraskar

Nine Panchayats were conferred with this prestigious award for their holistic approach to implementing sustainable development goals across all themes.

3. Gram Urja Swaraj Vishesh Panchayat Puraskar

Recognizing innovation in renewable energy, Panchayats from **Maharashtra**, **Odisha**, **and Tripura** were awarded for their remarkable contributions to sustainable energy practices.

4. Carbon Neutral Vishesh Panchayat Puraskar

Highlighting environmental sustainability, Gram Panchayats from **Maharashtra**, **Odisha**, **and Uttar Pradesh** were honoured for their efforts in achieving net-zero carbon emissions.

5. Panchayat Kshamta Nirmaan Sarvottam Sansthan Puraskar

Institutions from **Kerala, Maharashtra, and Odisha** were recognized for providing exceptional support to Panchayats in implementing Localization of Sustainable Development Goals.

Financial Recognition and Support

A total of **46 crore rupees** in prize money was distributed to 45 awardees, with funds directly transferred to their accounts. This financial recognition aims to motivate and support rural governance initiatives.

Key Publications and Documentation

A significant highlight was the unveiling of a booklet titled **'Best Practices on Works of Awardee Panchayats'**, documenting the innovative practices of award-winning Panchayats and serving as a knowledge repository for other rural governance institutions.

Indian Heritage Conservation Projects Shine at UNESCO Asia-Pacific Awards 2024

Two Indian heritage conservation projects—the Abathsahayeswarar Temple Conservation Project in Tamil Nadu and the BJPCI Conservation Project in Maharashtra—have garnered global recognition by winning the UNESCO Asia-Pacific Awards for Cultural Heritage Conservation 2024. These projects, celebrated for their commitment to preserving India's cultural legacy, were among the eight winners selected from the Asia-Pacific region.

The awards, announced by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) on 6 December 2024 at its regional office in Bangkok, Thailand, spotlight the efforts of individuals and organisations dedicated to restoring and conserving heritage sites across the region.

Abathsahayeswarar Temple Conservation Project

- The **Abathsahayeswarar Temple Conservation Project** in **Thukkatchi**, **Tamil Nadu**, received the **Award of Distinction**, recognizing its exemplary efforts to safeguard a historic cultural treasure.
- Temple Overview
- The Abathsahayeswarar Temple, dedicated to Lord Dakshinamurthy (a form of Lord Shiva), is a revered religious site located in
 Thukkatchi village in the Thiruvarur District of Tamil Nadu. The temple holds historical and spiritual significance, as it is
 mentioned in the 7th-century Tamil Saivite text 'Thevaram' and is one of the Paadal Petra Sthalams (sacred places glorified in
 Tamil Shaivite literature).

Award-Winning Conservation Efforts

The conservation project was lauded for its innovative use of modern engineering expertise alongside the traditional knowledge
of Hindu temple builders, known as sthapathis, to ensure the structural conservation of the temple. This harmonious blend of
traditional and modern techniques exemplifies a sustainable approach to heritage preservation, earning the temple the UNESCO
Award of Distinction.
