Sutton for their groundbreaking work in reinforcement learning (RL), which laid the foundation for AI advancements. Their influential publication, "Reinforcement Learning: An Introduction" (1998), has been cited over 75,000 times. The award, often called the "Nobel Prize in Computing," carries a \$1 million prize, sponsored by Google.

Meanwhile, director Brady Corbet (The Brutalist) and lead actor Adrien Brody (The Brutalist) secured top honors. The awards also saw Dune: Part Two winning in technical categories, while Wallace & Gromit: Vengeance Most Fowl took home Best Animated Film.

The temple holds historical and spiritual significance, as it is mentioned in the 7th-century Tamil Saivite text 'Thevaram' and is one of the Paadal Petra Sthalams (sacred places glorified in Tamil Shaivite literature).

 The conservation project was lauded for its innovative use of modern engineering expertise alongside the traditional knowledge of Hindu temple builders, known as sthapathis, to ensure the structural conservation of the temple.
